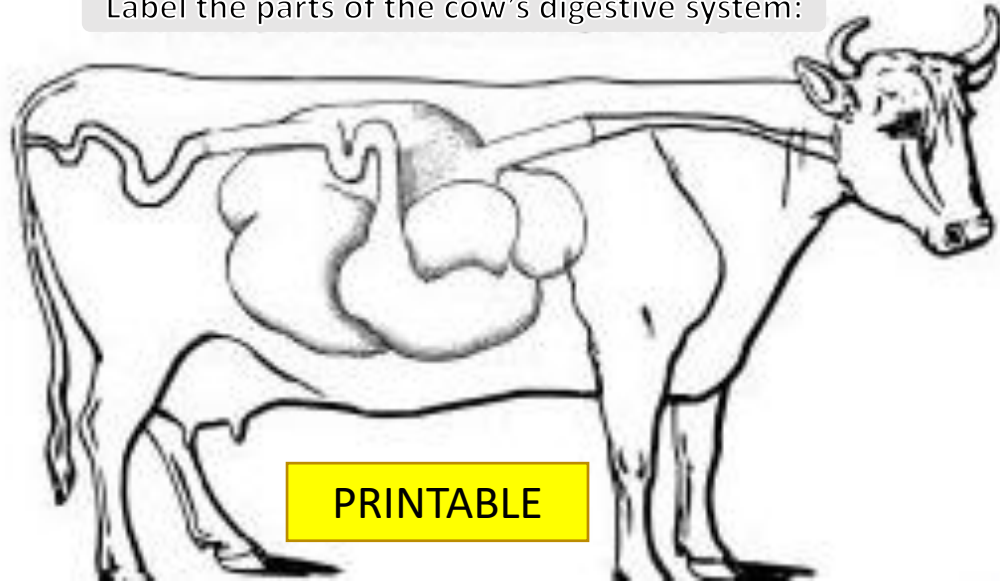


Write the number that corresponds to each stage of the cow's digestive process in the order it occurs

- ☐ The cow eats the grass
- ☐ The abomasum removes additional nutrients from the cud
- ☐ The cud is passed back to the cow's mouth
- ☐ The grass is broken down into small pieces (cud) by the reticulum
- ☐ The grass is stored in the rumen and digestion is started
- ☐ The cud is passed into the intestines
- ☐ The cud is passed into the omasum for nutrient absorption
- ☐ The remaining cud is processed by the intestines and turned into cow manure
