JCU Townsville, Bebegu Yumba, Douglas campus – 12 and 13 July.

This program provides students from regional and remote areas the opportunity to participate in UniX. Local students who would like to experience what it's like to live on-campus are also invited to apply. Students will gain experience staying in university residential accommodation whilst also increasing self-confidence, self-efficacy and building awareness about university life.

Student Registration

Schools that have chosen to participate in our UniX Residential Program to be held at JCU Townsville, Bebegu Yumba, Douglas campus – 13, 14 and 15 July 2021 are required to have students and their parent/guardian complete the 2021 UniX Senior [Accommodation Registration Form](#). Schools are required to email the completed form to futurestudents@jcu.edu.au before the closing date on 25 June 2021. All accommodation meals and dietary requirements will be catered for students and staff attending the Residential Program.

Residential Program Cost

The cost for meals and accommodation is \$90 per student/staff member. JCU will invoice the school post event for payment. Cost recovery by the school from participating students before or after the event is at the discretion of the school. A travel-subsidy maybe offered to your school to assist with transport costs. Your school's Relationship Manager will contact you with details on how to take advantage of this offer.

Residential Program Transport

Schools are required to coordinate their own transport to and from JCU Townsville, Bebegu Yumba, Douglas campus. JCU understands the cost burden of transporting students and a travel subsidy maybe available to your school to assist with transport costs. FAQs

- *Why is it only a half day?*
We understand how difficult it can be to release students from their usual school program for a full day so we've streamlined the event to be able to showcase the best of JCU with hands-on, interactive activities.
- *Can we register for both morning and afternoon sessions?*
You may choose to register for multiple sessions depending on the timetable for your different year levels. It is recommended that students only attend one session though.
- *How will the Student Sessions be different to the Parent Session?*
The Student Sessions will be focused on experiential learning with hands-on, and interactive activities. The Parent Session will allow parents and carers to seek information directly from Colleges and Support Services as well as listen to a range of short presentations.
- *How will the Student Sessions be structured?*
Once your students arrive at JCU we'll check them in and they'll be able to access the designated event space. Students will be immersed in the university environment and gain insight into the different courses and career opportunities that are available. They will also have the opportunity to talk to Student Ambassadors about what it's like to study at JCU, learn about all the social aspects of uni life, chat with Academic Staff, and find out about all the support services that will be available to them.
- *Will lunch be provided for students and teachers?*
