ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The promoter of this competition is the Mount Isa Centre for Rural and Remote Health (MICRRH), James Cook University (JCU).

The competition is open now and closes on Friday 31 December 2017.

Entries must:

- Be your own original photo taken during your 2017 clinical placement.
- Reflect your placement experience in the outback.
- Be original and creative – think outside the box show why your placement was so special.
- Include a quote of no more than 100 words summarising how the photo illustrates your placement experience.
- If your image includes people (including your own) everyone must complete an [Image Release Consent form available here.](#)
- **MAXIMUM 2 ENTRIES PER STUDENT**

PRIZES

- An Akubra Hat for the best photo overall.
- 'Mount Isa' Monopoly for the second best photo overall.
- 'Mount Isa' Monopoly for the third best photo overall.

HOW TO ENTER

- Enter online at www.jcu.edu.au/mount-isa-centre-for-rural-and-remote-health.
- Complete the entry form and upload your entry or entries (maximum 2 per student).
- Each person whose images are used must complete an Image [Release Consent form](#).
- Upload your entry and the completed Image Release Consent form (if required).

COMPETITION RULES

- Entries close 6pm, Friday 31 December 2017 AEDST.
- Students may enter a maximum of 2 entries.
- Entries must be student's own original work from a rural or remote placement completed in 2017.

- Entries must include a 100 words (maximum) explaining how the photo illustrates your placement experience OR how your rural experience changed you.
- Open to domestic and international undergraduate health science/therapy students in any discipline undertaking a placement in 2017.
- Permission from each person shown in every entry must be obtained using the [Image Release Consent form](#).
- All entries may be used in the future by MICRRH, JCU online, in print publications and other media.
- Winners will be notified by email and/or mobile phone.
- The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence about results will be entered into.
