#### PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATION STATUS

Pending accreditation for the Accounting Major which will be jointly accredited by CPA Australia and the Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand (CAANZ).

#### ADDITIONAL COURSE RULES

- A maximum of 30 credit points may be taken at level 1
- A minimum of 18 credit points must be taken at level 2
- A minimum of 18 credit points must be taken at level 3

#### COURSE PROGRESSION REQUISITES

Must successfully complete 12 credit points at level 1 before attempting any level 3 subject.

This course has a Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) program culminating in a third year core subject. Students must successfully complete the prescribed WIL preparation modules and quizzes to be eligible to apply for a WIL capstone subject.

#### PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS

**Pending accreditation with CPA and CAANZ for the Accounting Major within this program.**

To be eligible for accreditation with Certified Practising Accountants (CPA Australia) and/or the Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand (CAANZ) students must complete the Accounting major that consists of 30 credit points.
