

# Research Integrity Training for Researchers

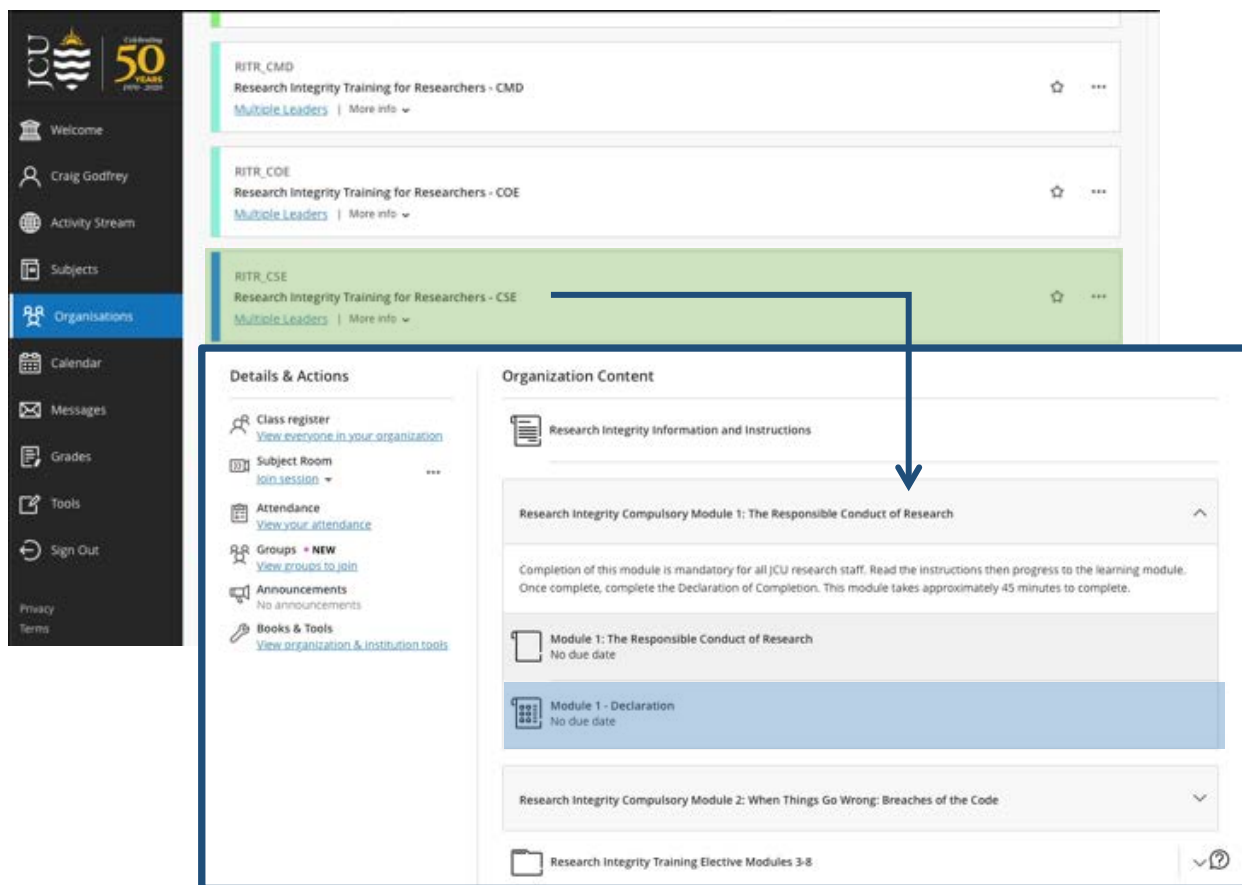
Compulsory Research Integrity Training modules can be found in a LearnJCU Organisation for your College.

- **Research Integrity Compulsory Module 1: The Responsible Conduct of Research**, will take approximately 45 minutes to complete.
- **Research Integrity Compulsory Module 2: When Things Go Wrong: Breaches of the Code**, will take approximately 25 minutes to complete.

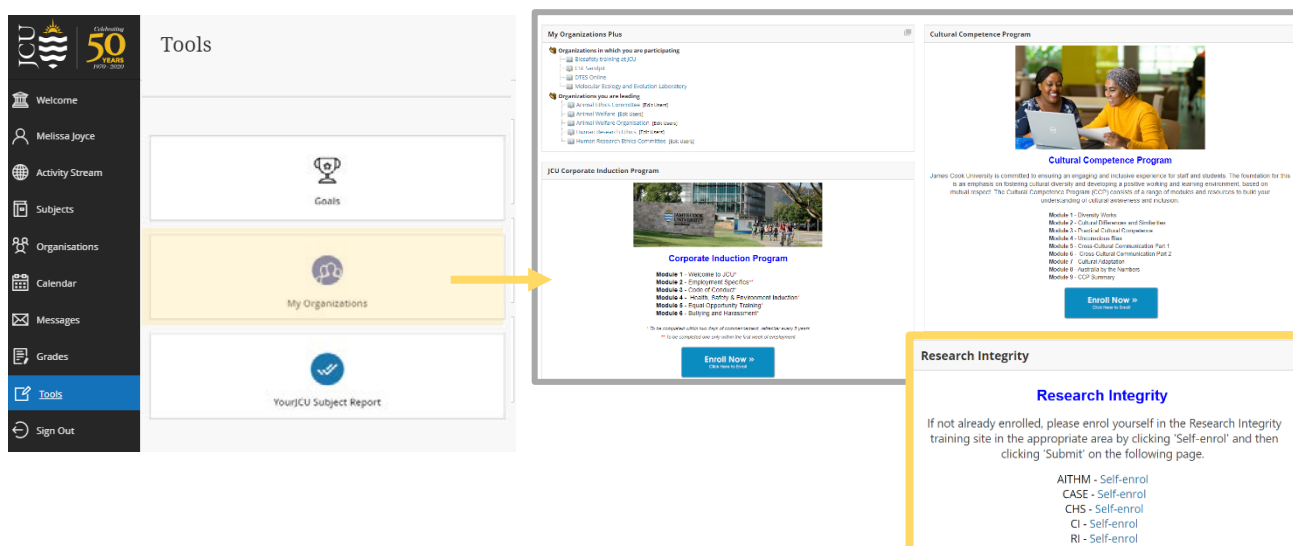
Research Integrity Training Elective Modules 3-8 are not compulsory, but it is recommended that researchers complete the modules.

The instructions below outline how to access the modules, complete the training declarations and self-enrol.

1. Login to LearnJCU (<https://www.jcu.edu.au/learn>) and navigate to your Organisations.
2. Choose the appropriate module, and follow the links to launch the training. If the modules are not accessible you will need to self-enrol first.
3. When done, complete the training declaration.



4. To self-enrol, from the left sidebar click on Tools then Organisations and enrol in the appropriate site.
