Compulsory Research Integrity Training modules can be found in a LearnJCU Organisation for your College/Directorate.


- Research Integrity Compulsory Module 1: The Responsible Conduct of Research, will take approximately 45 minutes to complete.
- Research Integrity Compulsory Module 2: When Things Go Wrong: Breaches of the Code, will take approximately 25 minutes to complete.

Research Integrity Training Elective Modules 3-8 are not compulsory, but it is highly recommended that researchers complete these modules.

- 1. Login to LearnJCU (https://www.jcu.edu.au/learn) and navigate to you Organisations.
- 2. Choose the appropriate module and follow the links to launch the training. If the modules are not accessible to you, please email researchintegrity@jcu.edu.au and we will enrol you manually in the training site.
- 3. When done complete the Training Declaration for Modules 1 and 2 Clicking on 'True' and submitting your answer to declare that you have completed the module.
- 4. Later, complete the Elective Modules 3-8 (there are no Training Declarations for these optional modules).
