

## Category A & Category B Clinical Placement Checklist

If you are not compliant with the requirements of the [Addressing vaccine preventable disease: Occupational assessment, screening and vaccination Policy](#) you will not be permitted to participate in a Clinical Placement within a SA Health Service.

You must tick every box in the relevant risk category below (A or B) and provide a copy of documentary evidence of your immunisation history as indicated.

Seasonal influenza vaccine and COVID-19 vaccine are not mandatory immunisations for clinical placement however, it is <b>strongly recommended</b> to have these vaccinations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SA Health has a duty of care and a responsibility under the <a href="#">Work Health and Safety Act 2012</a>: to minimise the transmission of vaccine preventable diseases (VPD) in the workplace, and the impact VPDs may have on its workers.</li> <li>Health care workers (HCW) have an increased risk of acquiring some vaccine preventable diseases (including influenza and COVID-19) and of transmitting these diseases to other HCWs, patients/clients, and visitors in SA Health services.</li> </ul>
