- If sending your application by post, please ensure it arrives on time, applications received after 31 August 2018 will not be accepted.
- Applicants should attach certified copies of their final year 12 results and/or tertiary academic transcript as applicable. Send only certified copies as originals cannot be returned to you.

Declaration and Document Certification Requirements

When preparing your application to James Cook University, it is essential that you supply correct and complete supporting documentation. Failure to do so may affect your selection.
