

System Components

- 1x ceiling mounted projector
- 2 wall mounted powered speakers
- All-in-one desktop PC with inbuilt camera and microphone for Mediasite Desktop Recordings
- Wireless Presenter Interface
- HDMI cable with Liberty adaptors – to connect digital laptops

AMX 8-button keypad

The AMX 8-button keypad is used for all interaction with the AV system



Log in to desktop PC

Use your JCU issued username and your password

Duplicate or Extend desktop PC display

Hold down the Windows key and press the P-key on the keyboard to access the PC display settings. Select 'Duplicate' on the floating menu. To show PowerPoint with notes, select 'Extend' from the floating menu.

Show Presentation

Turn the system on by pressing the *System ON* button – the projector will only take a few moments to warm up.

Desktop PC

Press the *PC* button on the keypad to show the desktop PC on the projector screen. We recommend using the VLC media player on the desktop PC to play downloaded material.

Laptop

1. Connect the laptop to the AV system using the provided HDMI cable,
2. Duplicate or Mirror the laptop display and press the *Laptop* button to show it on the projector screen.

Wireless Presenter

Press the *Present* button on the keypad to show the interface on the projector screen

Take note of the *Room Name* (IP address) and *Code* then follow the instructions for how to connect.

Volume control

Ensure the desktop PC and laptop volume is turned up and not muted if the presentation contains an audio component. The PC, laptop and wireless presenter speaker volume is controlled by turning the round button on the keypad.
