Overview

The appearance of the Menu Style can be changed to create uniformity within a subject or to match banners or logos. The display of the menu can be text or buttons with a large range of button styles and colours to choose from.

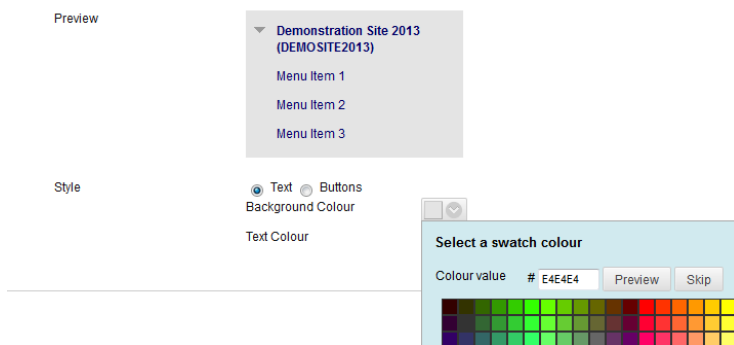
Changing Menu Styles

1. From within your subject site go to **Control Panel > Customisation** to expand the customisation menu
2. Choose **Style**.

In the **Select Menu Style** section a preview of the current menu style is shown

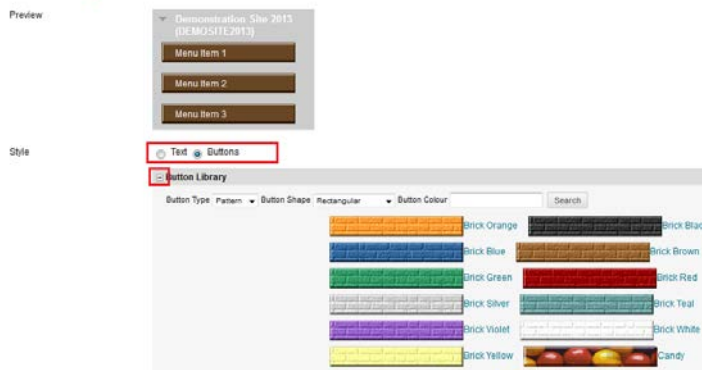
- For **Text Menus**, choose Text option and use the pulldown next to **Background Colour** and **Text Colour** to select required colours. Select **Apply**

2. Select Menu Style



- For **Button Style Menu**, click on **+ Button Library** to view button choices
Use the pulldown menus to **Select Button Type, Button Shape**

2. Select Menu Style



3. In the **Subject Menu Display** select which **Default Menu View** is required
 - **Folder view**
 - **List View** or
 - **Permit both Views**

4. Click **Submit**.

Menu Style choices will be reflected in the subject menu.
