Top women researchers honoured in productivity awards

Congratulations to Dr. Zoe Bainbridge who was presented with a Women in Research Citation Award at a ceremony in Canberra!

This award was designed by Thomson Reuters IP and Science and presented by ANU Vice-Chancellor and Nobel Laureate Prof. Brian Schmidt. You don't get nominated, they undertake an extensive search of researchers citation achievements. Their selection process began with a total of 977,500 papers published from 2000-2015 with Aust or NZ ID's. Selection criteria (e.g. female, mid-early career) reduced this down to 343,500 authors. From that list, they selected the author who had the best overall performance in each of the 11 domains. Performance of authors was measured by the highest percentage of papers in the top 10% when the number of papers was higher than the median of their domain. Zoe was the winner of the Env'tl Science and Mgt domain.

Zoe did her PhD at JCU and will return to JCU (TROPWATER) in November on an Advance Qld Fellowship, tracing sources of sediment to the GBR and their fate there. Congratulations Zoe – this is a huge honour.

Australian Academy of Science – Awards 2017

The Inaugural Max Day Environmental Science Fellowship Award

This inaugural Fellowship is named in honour of Dr Maxwell Frank Cooper Day AO FAA who is the longest serving Fellow of the Academy and who has spent a lifetime championing entomology, conservation and forestry, and helping other scientists.

Dr Day and his family are generously funding this Fellowship to support scientists early in their careers, acknowledging the support that Dr Day himself received as a young researcher to travel overseas to gain his PhD at Harvard.

This is an annual award of up to \$20,000 to assist PhD students or early career researchers. It provides funding support toward the costs of travel, courses or research, or to supplement PhD scholarships with necessary top-up funding.
