## The course entry requirements for JCU's Bachelor of Pharmacy (Honours) degree in 2021 were:

ATAR/rank 79.3      English (Units 3/4,C), Chemistry (3/4,C), Mathematical Methods (3/4,C)

Your ATAR/rank will be based on your results from previous study such as completed secondary school, TAFE Diplomas, completed/partially completed Tertiary study or employment experience.


## Pathway options

### Certificate of Higher Education

If you meet the ATAR/rank for pharmacy but are missing Maths and/or Chemistry, then the Certificate of Higher Education is the pathway for you. You'll complete the studies online in short intensive blocks over the summer period, preparing you to start your pharmacy degree in February.

### Diploma of Higher Education

The six-month to one-year full-time course in Cairns and Townsville is designed to help you if you want to study pharmacy but need to improve or gain an ATAR/rank, or if you are missing the pre-requisite subjects. Maybe it's been a while since you studied, or you didn't finish Year 12. No matter your circumstances, the JCU team are here to help you succeed.
