Study abroad and get credit towards your degree

- Study abroad for a semester or two with the Exchange Program
- Receive credit towards your degree

Tanya spent a semester at the Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, USA when studying her Bachelor of Business – Management. “The highlights were meeting amazing people, growing as a person, making friends from all over the world and experiencing ‘the American dream’,” she said.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for the Exchange program you must:

- be currently enrolled in a full degree program
- have a minimum GPA of 4.5
- have successfully completed at least one year of full-time study (24 credit points at JCU) by the time you depart for your exchange
- have approval from your College

Financial Assistance

Australian Government Endeavour Mobility program grants are available to eligible students. Ask about University or country specific scholarships.

Eligible students can access the Overseas Higher Education Loan Program (OS-HELP) or Centrelink payments while overseas.

Where can I go?

It is important that you choose an exchange destination that is right for you. Consider the following:

- How will you handle the different culture?
- Do you want to improve or gain language skills?
- What will the climate be like?
- Are there any activities or interests that you would like to take up while overseas?

When on exchange you must take comparable subjects at your exchange university that will be credited towards your JCU degree. In order to be granted credit, you must obtain advice and receive approval from your College, and pass approved subjects while on exchange.
