

# Centrelink Relocation Scholarship or JCU Indigenous Relocation Scholarship

To be eligible for the Centrelink Relocation Scholarship or the JCU Indigenous Relocation Scholarship you will need to meet the following criteria:

- Are studying full time
- are dependent and need to live away from your family home to study
- are relocating to or from a regional or remote area to study
- currently receive either ABSTUDY or Youth Allowance
- for JCU Relocation Scholarships meet the Financial Support requirements

You will NOT be eligible for the Centrelink Relocation Scholarship if you:

- are from a major city area and studying in a major city, even if you have to relocate from one city to another to study
- only get [Pharmaceutical Allowance](#) or [Rent Assistance](#) or both, because your Youth Allowance or ABSTUDY payment rate is \$0.
- get a [Commonwealth Accommodation Scholarship](#) (or [Indigenous Relocation Scholarship](#) offered by JCU) - including if you were eligible but didn't receive it because your payment was suspended
- get a [Relocation Scholarship](#) from the Department of Veterans' Affairs
- live on campus and receive [ABSTUDY Residential Cost Option](#) - except if the offer of a place in a residential college is received after the Relocation Scholarship is paid

## Comparison - which one is right for you

Centrelink Relocation Scholarship	JCU Indigenous Relocation Scholarship
\$4,376 in the first year	\$5,200 in the first year
\$2,189 in the second or third year	\$5,200 in the second and third year
\$1,094 in the fourth or subsequent year	\$5,200 in the fourth year (if you are still in full time study)
