



## AV Equipment Guide

# Using the AMX ENZO

This device is used for presenting and sharing documents stored on wireless devices, such as laptop, tablet or smartphone to a projector screen or flat panel display. ENZO is available in A3-001, 5-001, 25-001, 25-002 and 26-001.

### File types

ENZO supports the following file types:

- Office Documents (.doc, .docx, .xls, .xlsx, .ppt, .pptx, .pdf, .rtf, .txt, .pps, .ppsx)
- Images (.png, .jpg, .bmp, .gif)
- Video (.mp4 with H.264 video and AAC audio)

### Get started

1. To switch on the ENZO, touch the Wireless Collaboration button on the Touch Panel. A dedicated mouse for use with the ENZO is located on the lectern.
2. Using the ENZO mouse, click anywhere on the touch panel screen to continue.

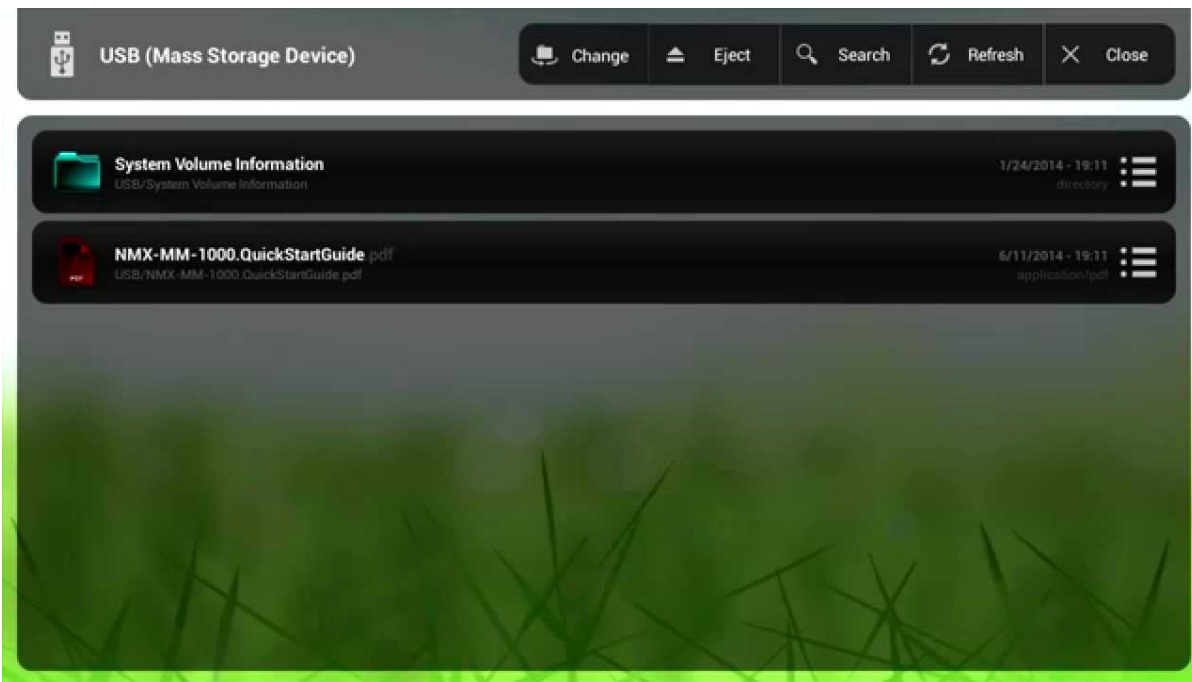

## USB

1) *Insert the USB stick into the USB port on the ENZO device*

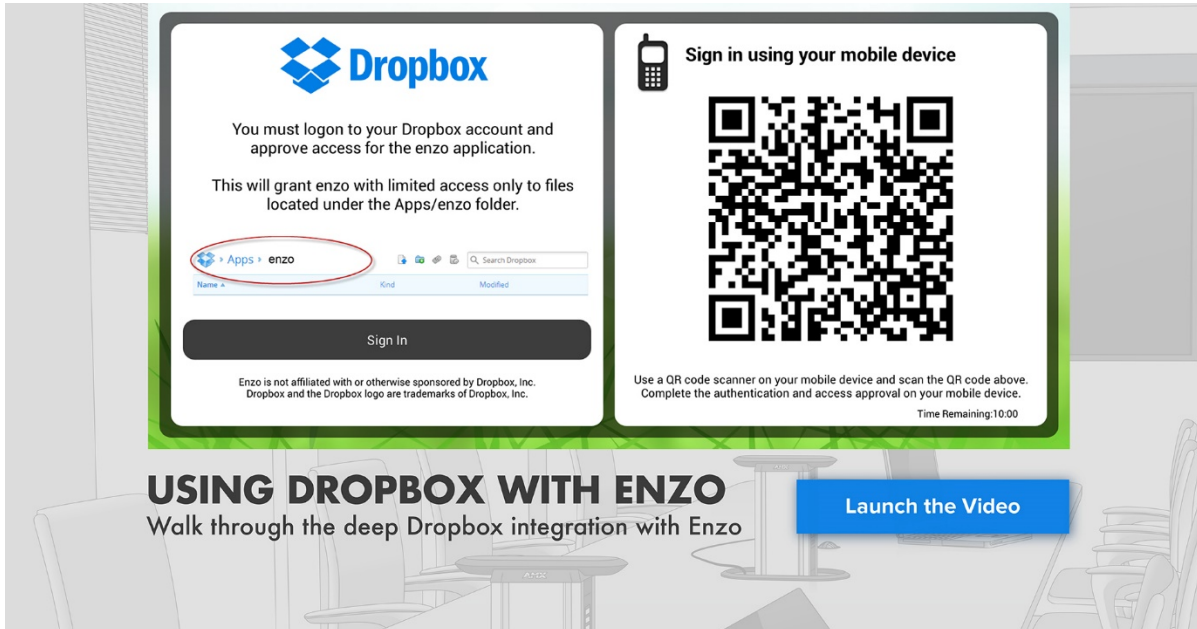


2) *Scroll through the files and select files to be presented by using the ENZO mouse*

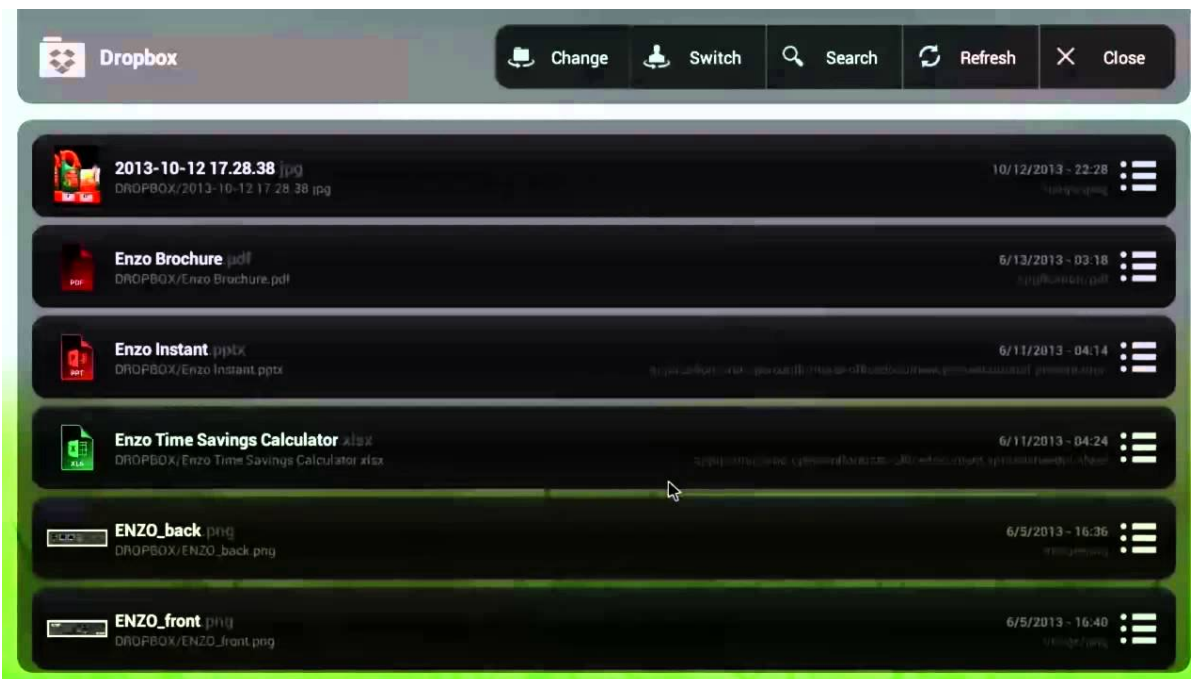
## Dropbox

Dropbox may be accessed using either of the following methods

1. Click on the Sign In bar and log in to Dropbox
2. Use a mobile device to scan the QR code offered on the touch panel. You have ten minutes to scan the QR code before it expires. If it does, reload the Enzo page for a new code

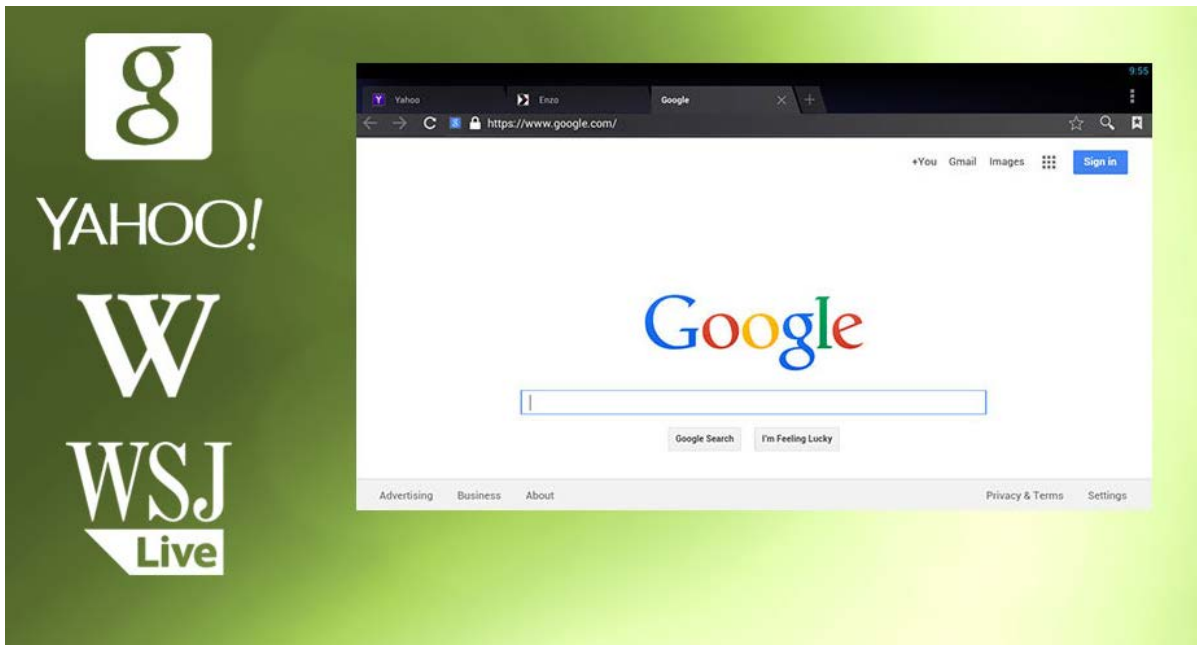
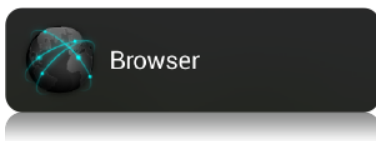
- Launch the app
- Click on MirrorOp on the ENZO screen and the following screen appear



- Enter the IP address shown and the code into your device.

The content displayed on your device will now be shown on the projector screen.

## Inbuilt Browser



*The built in web browser allows users to search the web for information to share in a meeting. Simply open the browser and navigate to your selected websites. Multiple tabs within the browser allow you to view numerous websites easily.*

## Dedicated Applications

Enzo has a dedicated Applications button which makes it easy to find your most commonly used web based apps by simply creating a shortcut. Apps can be launched directly from here into a full screen window to maximize application viewing. Click on the Applications button to launch.
