Position Overview

The Biodiversity Coordinator will be responsible for monitoring and recording biodiversity on site including flora, micro and macro fauna (introduced and endemic), coming up with creative ways of increasing biological diversity, and creating info-graphics detailing their findings.

The Biodiversity Coordinator will become a member of the JCU Community Garden Working Group. The Working Group is the primary governance body for the Community Garden; it meets monthly.

The primary role of this position is managing and recording biodiversity.

A secondary role is to coordinate a team of volunteers to help with this important work.
