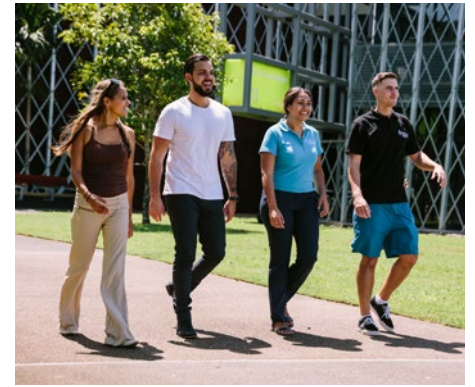

Kick start your future at a one-week residential program for Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander high school students. Get to know James Cook University, build a network of friends and take part in a range of inter educational activities.

Experience University

The JCU Winter School for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Students offers Year 10, 11, and 12 students the chance to experience university life during the July school holidays. Over five days, you will take part in academic lectures and tutorials, presentations, study sessions as well as team-building activities. The interactive program provides opportunities to meet University staff and students, as well as form bonds with other Indigenous students in the program.

The Winter School will be held at James Cook University's Townsville Campus. The Indigenous Education and Research Centre and other University staff will deliver the activities and provide supervision and support. The University covers the cost of return travel, including flights, bus or train, for students outside of the Townsville region. Accommodation is in residential colleges on the University campus and catering is provided for all participants while students are on campus.

During the week, you will have the chance to develop an appreciation for a particular area of study. Whether you already know what you would like to study or are curious to find out more, this is a great way to sample an area of study. You can choose from the following discipline areas*:
