
Equip yourself with the skills and knowledge to succeed in enterprise at both a local and national level with JCU's Bachelor of Business.

Are you an Australian Defence Force (ADF) member seeking to advance your career with a formal business qualification? In less than two years you could receive a Bachelor of Business whilst studying part-time around your work commitments.

The Army Tertiary Education Program (ATEP) enables ADF personnel to receive advanced standing (study credit) in recognition of their military academic qualifications and professional experience. Eligible applicants can enter JCU's Bachelor of Business in the final year of study (Year 3) and can choose to complete a major in either Human Resources Management or Management.

Majors

Students entering the Bachelor of Business under the ATEP are required to complete three core subjects and can then choose to major in either Human Resources Management or Management.

Core subjects:

- Accounting for Decision Making (BU1002:03)
- Principles of Data Analysis for Business (BU1007:03)
- Principles of Economics (BU1003:03)

Students majoring in Management are also required to take the subject, 'The Future of Work: Seminar Series' (BU2001:03).

How to Apply

To be eligible for advanced standing applicants must provide a Letter of Attestation from their Education Officer that confirms that they meet all of the following criteria:

- Achieved 2400+ hours of professional development and/or training relevant to the Bachelor of Business degree.
- Successfully completed an All Corps Captain Course or Warrant Officer Course.
- Have completed a minimum of four years full-time employment in the ADF in a leadership or management position.

Once you are ready to commence your application for entry into the Bachelor of Business we ask that you contact us directly so we can fast-track your application and waive your application fee. Your application must reach us before the deadline for your course.
