# MAKE YOURSELF HEARD TODAY

The **why** elevates your feedback to give it context.

Saying that you did or didn't like something is only one part of your experience.

We can take action if we understand the reasons why.



## **FIND THE** WHY IN YOUR WHAT

Consider cause and effect. The WHAT leads to the WHY.

WHAT happened: We moved to online learning

The result is your WHY: I miss being able to discuss the subject with other students



## WHAT WE HAVE ΗFAR SO FAR

In previous surveys you've described your student life experiences, both positive and negative.

They range from lecture engagement to subject relevance and everything in between.

Here are some examples.



### EXAMPLE 1

#### Your WHAT:

"Our lecturer did not post the PowerPoint slides until after the lecture ..."

#### Your WHY:

"... which meant I could not annotate them during the lecture and take notes in a way that is effective for me."





#### Your WHAT:

"The subject was comprehensive and well-paced ..."

#### Your WHY:

"... so I felt challenged, but not overwhelmed."


