Overview	The Scholarship aims to assist academically outstanding but disadvantaged students, from a rural or regional area , who have been offered a full-time place at an Australian university or college for the first time.

Scholarship type	Need based, Merit based
Year of study	First year undergraduate bachelor degree
Duration	One year initially but may be awarded for up to two years (dependent upon academic performance)
Intention of Scholarship	Accommodation costs and/or other expenses directly related to the study of successful applicants (eg. course costs, study related materials/equipment, text books, tutoring)
Award Value (per student)	Award values remain at the discretion of the special Committee. Award value is \$5,000 (per annum) based on previous years
Eligibility	To be eligible, the following criteria must be met: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Australian citizen or permanent resident from a rural or regional location• first year undergraduate in 2018 (first attendance at an Australian university)• studying full-time in 2018 (in an approved Australian course)• graduated from secondary school in either 2017 or in 2016 (taken a gap year)• demonstration of the disadvantage (economic and/or social) hindering further study• outstanding academic achievement and community involvement
Nationality	Australian citizen or permanent resident
Applications open	1 December 2017
Applications close	29 January 2018

Criteria	Scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of a selection committee and will be assessed on academic achievement, demonstrated disadvantage and community contribution.
