 - NAPLAN results for school years 3, 5, 7, 9, wherever available
 - year 11 and year 12 school reports (if you are a recent school leaver)
 - Queensland Senior Statement and Tertiary Entrance Statement, or equivalents

 - a supporting letter, preferably from your year 12 school principal [school leavers]; and/or from your employer [work experienced candidates]; otherwise, from a non-relative who knows you very well
