Notice is hereby given that an Election by electronic ballot of one (1) Professional and Technical Staff of the University by and from the Professional and Technical Staff to the Council of James Cook University will be conducted between Friday 23 March and Friday 6 April 2018. Voting in the election is now open.

Each Professional and Technical Staff member is entitled to vote for one candidate before you click 'cast vote'.

Elected Professional and Technical Staff members onto the Council of James Cook University are appointed for a period of four years, commencing 20 April 2018.

The elected Professional and Technical Staff member on the Council of James Cook University is elected for a period of four (4) years, commencing 20 April 2018.

Professional and technical staff of the University - for the purposes of the policy, includes the staff of the University other than its academic staff.
