

- Benefit from a multi-faceted approach to learning. Undertake an individual research project, or take advantage of a domestic or international internship that will expand your professional network.
- ✓ Fast-track your degree with credit for previous study. If you have a Bachelor's degree or a Graduate Certificate in a related discipline, you may be able to complete the Master's degree in 1.5 years. If you have a Bachelor Honours degree or a Graduate Diploma in a related discipline, you may be able to complete the Master's degree in 1 year.

Program specialisation streams include disaster resilience and natural resource management, public health, sustainable planning and policy, indigenous futures; governance, leadership and management, and global development research."

Postgraduate coursework applications

Apply directly to JCU, either by a form you download, complete and return, or by using the Online Application Portal.

Your application must reach us before the deadline for your course.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Postgraduate courses will usually require completion of an appropriate undergraduate degree for entry. You'll need to include certified copies of qualifications and academic records with your application. For some programs, appropriate work experience or equivalent qualifications will be considered.
