Majors

A Master of Education at JCU offers two majors. Students have the opportunity to design, plan and execute a substantial research and/or inquiry-based project.

Educational Leadership

Develop advanced knowledge and understanding of ethical practices within educational leadership. Critically reflect on current issues facing the profession and understand the key aspects of both becoming a leader and developing this capacity in others. Embrace the future of education by examining how best to combine teaching philosophies with the changing landscape of digital literacy. Become equipped to face local and global challenges to education and technology. Hone your curriculum design and implementation skills to lead pedagogical changes with confidence.

Educational Research

Investigate a topic or issue of your choice within the field of education. You will undertake a small-scale research project, producing a 10,000 – 12,000-word dissertation under the guidance of supportive research advisors committed to your success. Understand the principles of research design and become skilled in analysing research data and justifying your chosen methodology. Finish your project by drawing conclusions and highlighting the implications of your findings. You will become experienced in communicating your research and ideas to a variety of audiences. Successful completion of this option can lead to a higher degree by research study.


