Copying an entire LearnJCU subject site

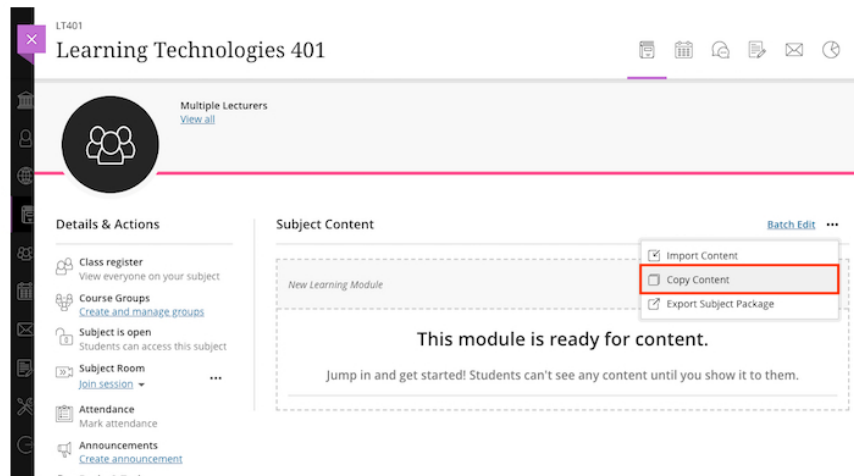

The content of LearnJCU subject sites are not automatically 'rolled over' to the next study period. If the same content is required from one study period to the next, the content of a whole site can be transferred to another LearnJCU subject site. In LearnJCU Ultra subjects, staff can perform a content copy themselves provided they have the same role in both the source and destination subjects (eg. Lecturer).

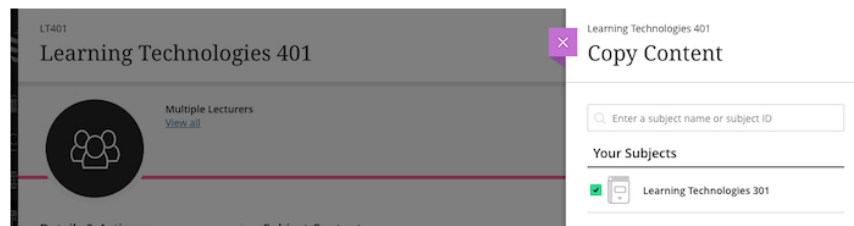

Instructions

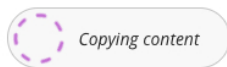
1. Log into the LearnJCU and open your **destination** subject site (ie. where you are copying the content TO). In most cases this will be an empty subject shell.
2. From the More options (...) menu on the top right choose **Copy Content**



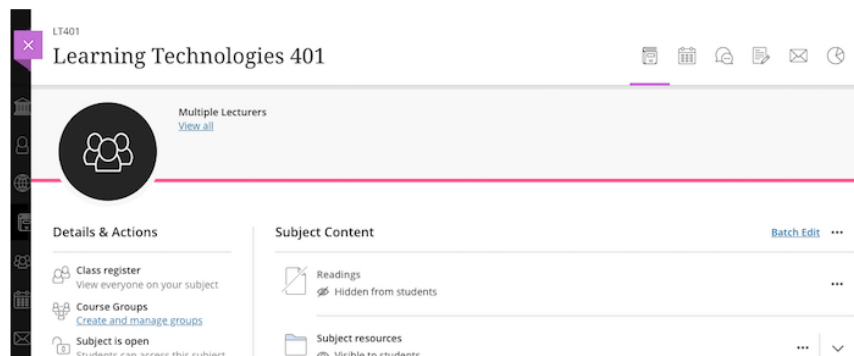
3. In the Copy Content peak panel click the checkbox next to the **source** subject (ie. where you are copying the content FROM).



4. Click the **Copy Selected Content** button at the bottom of the peak panel. The Copying Content indicator will be displayed at the bottom of the page while your content is being copied. This may take a few minutes.



5. When copying is complete the content from your source subject site will be displayed in your destination subject site.
