RE: INSURANCE COVER – STUDENTS

Period 1 November 2014 to 1 November 2015

This letter confirms that James Cook University has the following forms of insurance in place to cover students in the normal course of the University's business including work placements / experience (*unpaid*) and field study trips and research activities.

- Public Liability

Legal Liability to pay compensation for third party injury or property damage (*excluding motor vehicles*), as a result of an occurrence and happening in connection with University business or University work placements / experience and / or site / field program.

- Professional Indemnity

Civil Liability arising out of a breach of professional duty by reason of any negligent act, error or omission committed or alleged to have been committed by the Insured Parties while acting solely in the conduct of Professional Services on behalf of the University (Geographical Limit is World Wide, excluding USA & Canada).


- Student Personal Accident

Cover including hospitalization and non-Medicare expenses for all students whilst on University related business.

- Corporate Travel insurance when undertaking authorised business travel on behalf of James Cook University or its Subsidiaries.

- Medical Malpractice insurance (for medical, nursing and allied health students) covering personal injury claims as a result of medical negligence provided the students are suitably supervised by an appropriately qualified person, it is a mandatory part of the course requirements and the patient consents to treatment (Geographical Limit is World Wide).
