How to create a rubric

- New rubrics default to three rows and three columns.
- In the **Control Panel**, expand the **Subject Tools** section and click Rubrics.
- On the **Rubrics** page, click **Create Rubric** on the action bar.
- Type a name and optionally, provide a description of the rubric to make it easier to associate it to relevant assignments.
- Edit the rubric grid.
- Click **Submit**.
