Transport

Arrival at Lucinda gated entry code 0015#

Luggage and other

WHAT TO BRING

- Bedlinen is provided
- Beach towel and bath towel are NOT provided
- Swimmers
- Snorkelling gear – mask, snorkel and fins (Snorkel gear can be borrowed as no expense from OIRS)
- Wetsuit or stinger suit, depending on the time of the year (Can be borrowed as no expense from OIRS)
- Reef walking gear – shoes/booties, shorts and long-sleeved shirt
- Sun protection – hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, rash shirt, water bottle
- (Underwater) camera / GoPro if you want
- Raincoat and warm jumper as it can be cold in evenings or out on the flats
- Seasickness tablets if needed (take 30 minutes before departure time)
- Toiletries incl. insect repellent, personal medication, and try to bring environmental friendly products
- Thongs
- Closed-in shoes which are mandatory in the lab area (OIRS standards)
- Re-usable water bottle
- Workshop items: laptop, mobile phone, paper and pen
- Torch to go around the research station at night
- Snacks!
- Good mood, sense of humour and enthusiasm
- A 'drink' for sunset on the beach
