

Student Placement Responsibilities and Guidelines

These responsibilities and guidelines are designed to help you make the most of your placement experience while ensuring a positive and productive relationship with your host organization. These responsibilities and guidelines are aligned with JCU's Professional Experience Placement Requirements Procedure.

Preparation: Ensure you have met all pre-placement requirements for the placement, including completion of mandatory documentation, attending inductions and reviewing all material provided.

Professionalism: Act in a professional and respectful manner at all times. Maintain a positive attitude and uphold the reputation of JCU complying with your responsibilities as outlines in JCU <u>Student Code of Conduct</u> policy.

Attendance: Attend your placement at the agreed-upon times and notify supervisors in advance if you are unable to attend on designated days.

Ethical Conduct: Act in accordance with ethical guidelines and respect confidentiality and intellectual property within the placement setting.

Active Learning: Take responsibility for your learning by actively participating in the learning process and making the most of all learning opportunities provided.

Learning Plan: Complete placement activities as outlined in your agreed-upon learning plan and/or curriculum in a professional manner, within the specified timeframe. Ensuring you take responsibility for your learning by engaging in the learning process and undertaking the learning opportunities provided.

Communication: Maintain open and effective communication with your placement supervisor and any relevant university staff members. If any problems or concerns arise, follow the processes outlined in your discipline-specific Student Handbook.

Compliance: Adhere to the specific rules and regulations of the placement host organization, including any dress code or safety protocols.

Health and Safety: Prioritize your safety and the safety of others by following all workplace health and safety requirements and promptly reporting any hazards or incidents.

Disability Support: JCU is committed to ensuring that students living with a disability and/or health condition have equal opportunities to access, engage, and participate in all levels of our university. If you have a documented disability or a short or long-term health condition, register with <u>AccessAbility</u> to access a range of support services and assistance to support you to succeed at JCU. We understand that you may not identify your condition as a 'disability'. However, if your health condition is impacting in any way on your placement please contact AccessAbility for advice and support. Refer to the <u>Student Disability Policy</u> for more information.

Any breach of these responsibilities and guidelines may result in <u>JCU's Review of a Students Suitability to Continue a Course Involving Placement</u> to be enacted.
