2. Limitation of Liability: The ATH disclaims any liability for any inaccuracies or errors in the identification of plant or fungi specimens. By using the ATH's services, the client acknowledges and agrees that the ATH shall not be held liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, or punitive loss or damage arising from the identification of plant or fungi specimens or any subsequent use of the identified plants by the client.

3. Client Responsibility: The client acknowledges and agrees that the use of the identified plants or fungi, based on the identification provided by the ATH, is solely at their own risk. The ATH shall not be responsible or liable for any consequences, damages, or claims resulting from the client's subsequent use of the identified plants or fungi.

4. Indemnification: The client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the ATH, its directors, officers, employees, and agents from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, costs, and expenses (including reasonable legal costs) arising out of or related to the use of the identification service provided by the ATH.
