

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

### **JCUGuest Wi-Fi access**

(for in-person participants only)

James Cook University provides wireless connectivity for all our guests, it has never been easier to stay connected to the internet on your devices when visiting our campuses.

Guest Wi-Fi service is only available on the Townsville Bebegu Yumba campus, Cairns Nguma-bada campus and their respective City campuses.

#### **Creating your account**

On your device, make sure that Wi-Fi is **ON**.

- 2. Open the list of available Wi-Fi networks and select JCUGuest
- 3. A new window will open. Enter your full name, your company name (optional), and your mobile phone number (required for authentication).
- 4. Check the box to accept the **terms and conditions**, which can be viewed following the link and are as per our acceptable use policy.
- 5. Click **Register** and your 6-digit passcode will be sent to your mobile number via SMS.
