### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Students wanting to enrol in HS5111:03 Alcohol and Other Drugs need to meet with the Master of Guidance Counselling course coordinator to gain approval for enrolment in this subject. HS5111:03 is to be studied concurrently with ED5310:03 Practicum in Guidance and Counselling and is only available to students doing their placement on a site that offers specific alcohol and drug related services. The site would need to agree to the student conducting their HS5111:03 assessment during their placement.

RM8501 and RM8502 are studied together over two study periods. Students cannot enrol into these subjects until their research project is approved and their research supervisor is assigned. Students need to contact the course coordinator to discuss their proposed project and have a supervisor assigned before enrolling in the subject.
