#### **HDR Advisor Check-In**

We know you are busy, but if you can take time out to complete an Advisor Check —In we would appreciate your advice. Only complete it for HDR Candidates who, based on current progress and unanticipated impacts of the pandemic, may require a Scholarship Extension and/or will not be eligible to graduate within 2 years full-time if they are enrolled in a Masters by Research or 4 years full-time if they are enrolled in a PhD. This information will assist us to anticipate additional scholarship expenses and potential reductions in completion rates. While we know the situation remains volatile, this advice will assist us in making preliminary recommendations to the University.

#### **Early Career Researcher Advisor Network**
