This public mapping tool may be used to assist in identifying the relevant Rainforest Aboriginal People for a given area within the Wet Tropics World Heritage Area (the Area).



2. The request download box will appear, select Google KML -KM - .kmz and download the file. The file will be emailed to your selected email address. Follow the instructions to download the file.





- 3. Add the Area boundary file 'Wet_Tropics_World_Heritage_Area.kmz' using the add data icon.




4. The upload file box will appear. Select 'add' and select the Area boundary file, then click upload.




5. The Area boundary file should appear under the upload folder, the boundary should also be depicted on the Public Map.






7. Select the polygon icon and type of polygon you wish to use to search (e.g. rectangle, circle, custom). Draw a polygon onto the map to select your area of interest.
